Board Giving Policy

1. CCEPA depends on board members to provide active leadership in ensuring the organization's financial sustainability. To safeguard financial health and operational excellence each board member is expected to actively participate in fundraising and to support the organization with an annual personal contribution.
2. To demonstrate commitment to CCEPA mission and to reach our fundraising goals, board members must first make a personal contribution themselves.
3. Such a personal contribution is distinct and is in addition to other in-kind contributions by board member such as committee participation, attendance at special events, helping to secure corporate sponsorship, organizing events, or otherwise participating in CCEPA programs and initiatives.
4. Recognizing the diverse nature of the CCEPA Board and the distinct financial situation of each board member, there will be no minimum amount expected for each board member's annual contribution. All that is required is for each board member to make a gift to CCEPA on an annual basis in accordance with his or her means at a level that demonstrates his or her commitment to the financial sustainability of CCEPA. Individual contributions will be kept confidential.
5. Recognizing that major funding sources take the board's financial contribution into account when assessing our organization as a potential beneficiary, members of the board commit to achieving 100% compliance with this policy every year.
6. All prospective board members will be given a copy of this policy.
